# 2011 WOMEN'S SOCCER SUMMER CAMPS

## CAMP PHILOSOPHY

The Ohio State Women's Soccer Camp is committed to excellence. Our goal is to provide a balanced learning environment that is both challenging and fun. Our camps have been developed specifically for the female soccer player and the curriculum is appropriate for all levels of players' abilities and ages - from the beginner to the aspiring college prospect. Our experienced camp staff will combine individual technical and tactical training with small and larger group tactics. In each camp session, campers are grouped by age, soccer ability and physical maturity.

## HALF-DAY CAMP

**JUNE 13 - 16 & JUNE 20 - 23 | Ages 6 - 11** 9 am - 11:30 am \$150/ \$175 (after June 1)

This 3-hour mini camp allows soccer players as young as 6 years old to share in the Buckeye excitement of learning the great game of soccer. Participation, fun and development are emphasized through small group games and activities. Our goal is to promote passion for the game and improve individual skills through daily repetition.

## DAY CAMP

**JUNE 13 - 16 & JUNE 20 - 23 | Ages 6 - 11** 9 am - 4 pm \$285/ \$310 (after June 1)

This full-day session balances individual skills, mini tournaments, and games with other athletic related activities. The day is broken up with lunch (campers need to bring their own lunch) and a rest/ movie time-out of the summer's heat and a swim in the pool (if available).

## NIGHT CAMP

**JUNE 19 - 22 | Ages 11 - 19** 5:45 pm - 8:45 pm \$150/ \$175 (after June 1)

This 3-hour evening camp is designed for the soccer player who cannot dedicate an entire day to camp activities. This session is an abridged version of the residential camp curriculum and is appropriate for middle and high school age players. Competition, fun and learning are emphasized through small group games and activities. Our goal is to improve individual skill through daily repetition.

## RESIDENTIAL CAMP

**JUNE 25 - 28 | Ages 11 - 19** \$550/ \$575 (after June 1)

This intensive individual camp will unite players by age and ability. Technical repetition, skillful decision making, individual defending, finishing, competitive fury, combative courage, enhanced footwork, coordination, speed and agility training will radiate throughout the curriculum. Mini tournaments and competitive matches will provide opportunities for individuals to improve and shine. High school age campers who aspire to compete as Division I student-athletes can experience collegiate fitness standards and interact with some of our current Buckeye Soccer players to learn what it takes to be the best! Our experienced camp staff, maintained at an 8:1 camper-to-counselor ratio, will balance the competition, fun, and learning. All meals are provided for campers and all campers will stay in 24 hour supervised, air conditioned dormitories on the OSU Campus. **\* There is a designated goalkeeping curriculum for this camp limited to ONLY high school aged campers. Spaces are limited. Please check the appropriate box on the registration form to identify camper as a goalkeeper.**

## TEAM NIGHT CAMP

**JUNE 19 - 22 | Ages 11 - 19** 5:45 pm - 8:45 pm **\$100/ \$125 (after June 1)**

This 3-hour evening camp is designed for high school age teams who aspire to improve their game and unite their team in a unique environment. Teams will work one-on-one with our senior staff to tailor the curriculum to each team's goals and needs. Group dynamics, speed of play, possession, box organization, team attacking, team defending, and transition will be emphasized and balanced with mini tournaments and matches against other teams. A team evaluation will be provided outlining strengths and weaknesses. A minimum of 12 players is required and a goalkeeper is encouraged. Teams must enroll together as a group. Please see more information under "Enrollment."

## TEAM RESIDENTIAL/COMMUTER CAMP

**JUNE 25 - 27 | Ages 11 - 19**  
**Res: \$350/\$375 (after June 1) Com: \$300/ \$325 (after June 1)**

This extensive team camp is designed for high school age teams who aspire to take their game to the championship level. Teams will work one-on-one with our senior staff to tailor the curriculum to each team's goals and specific needs. Each team will have six training sessions (1-Sat, 2-Sun, 1-Mon) and 3 games (1/day). Group dynamics, competitive fury, fitness standards, speed of play, possession, tactical problem solving, box organization, team attacking, team defending, and transition can be emphasized and balanced along with mini tournaments and matches against other teams. A team evaluation will be provided outlining strengths and weaknesses. All meals are provided for resident teams, and lunch and dinner are provided for teams who will be commuting. A minimum of 12 players are required and an adult coach and a goalkeeper are encouraged. Teams must enroll together as a group. Please see more information under "Enrollment." Teams will check-in on Saturday between 2 pm - 4 pm and depart on Monday prior to dinner.

## ENROLLMENT

A minimum of 12 campers is required to register for ANY Team Camp. Teams cannot register online. Each camper is to complete a separate registration form. Full payment must accompany each team member's registration form for the TEAM NIGHT CAMP, deposits will not be accepted. Full payment or a \$100 deposit is required from each camper when registering for the TEAM RESIDENTIAL or TEAM COMMUTER Camp. Full payment is required by June 1, 2011. Registrations postmarked after June 1, 2011 will be charged the Late Registration fee.

Completed applications and payments must be submitted together (no exceptions) in one envelope with a cover sheet that includes the coach's name, address, phone number and email address. If a team drops below 12 participants, the individual residential enrollment rate (\$575) will be applied to each camper. Individuals may be added to the team and teams can be subdivided into multiple teams if necessary, but all deadlines and fees apply. Each team must be accompanied by an adult coach. The team's camp fee includes room and board for one coach.

Full payment for all camps is required by June 1, 2011. Registrations postmarked after June 1, 2011 will be charged the Late Registration fee. Please make checks payable to The Ohio State University.
