Fee and Refund Policy

Fees

Upon acceptance of a roster spot, a parent or guardian must register their player on the appropriate team. It is expected that a deposit is made immediately to confirm the spot, and the remainder of fees will be paid by the agreed timeline as set forth in the online registration system. Credit card is the preferred method of payment. If paying by check, registration is not considered complete until the check has been received and the deposit has been cleared by the bank. Failure to make appropriate payments could result in the player being asked to leave the program.

Multiple Family Player Discounts

Families with multiple children will receive the following discounts:

First and Second player are paid in full.

Third player received \$150.00 discount per year.

Fourth, fifth or more players would each receive a 50% discount on their fees.

Trapped Players

Trapped Player – U15 player in 8th grade – pay full 15s fees, plus 30% of U14s

Reverse Trapped U14 player in HS playing ½ year in select – pay full 14s minus 30%

Player Refund

When a team is formed and players register for the team, they are making a commitment that is expected to last for the entire year. If after the team is formed, a player withdraws from the team, it places the remaining players at a disadvantage. In some cases, the team may now fall short of the required number of players to remain registered with the league. Players and families are expected to give serious consideration to this commitment when they register and commit to a team.

The fee refund policy for players who withdraw from a team after registering is as follows:

- For players who withdraw from a team voluntarily after registration, no refund is offered.
- For players who withdraw due to injury prior to the team playing half of their scheduled season games, consisting of league, tournaments and State Cup games, they shall receive a refund of 50% of their fees paid less administrative costs. Players must produce validation/verification from a doctor to receive such a refund.
- For players who withdraw due to injury after the team has played 50% or more of their season games, consisting of league, tournaments and State Cup games, no refund is offered.

Unusual situations, such as relocation of the family, will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Scholarships

Worthington Crew Juniors makes every effort to help families having financial hardship so their child can continue to play soccer. An application must be completed and returned to us upon acceptance of a roster spot to be considered for a scholarship. This process is confidential.

- **Only the Worthington Crew Juniors Board can approve scholarships.**
- **Coaches cannot award or approve scholarships.**
- **No player will receive a full scholarship.**
- **No player is guaranteed they will receive the same amount they received in a previous year.**

Scholarships are strictly to assist covering player fees and cannot be used for uniforms or travel expenses that are associated in playing for Worthington Crew Juniors.
