## Expectations

During the season, you should expect at least 3 to 4 soccer events every week. Each U9 to U14 team is expected to participate in league play, plus five to six additional events per year. Each U15 to U17 team is expected to participate in league play, plus an additional three to four events per year. U18 teams will participate in league play and an additional two to three events per year. These events may include tournaments, festivals, friendlies, State Cup or supplemental league play. Some teams may add additional programming at additional cost, which may be included at the time of the offer. The majority of our teams practice at Perry Middle School. Tournament selection, for all age groups, is determined by your coach and CJW Director of Coaching. You will be responsible for your own uniform expense, travel fees, including but not limited to gas, food and lodging. Your team administrator will coordinate hotel options for the team. Some teams may chose to do an additional tournament, for an additional fee.

## Team Offer Process

The majority of team offers will be extended via email on Sunday, after 2pm. Some players may receive offers via telephone, and others may receive offers as late as Monday evening. Detailed instructions on how to accept/decline an offer will be provided, at the time of the offer. If you have not received an email or phone call by Tuesday, please contact our CJW Director of Coaching.
